Understanding Perimeter

The **perimeter** of a figure is the distance around it.

The perimeter is found by adding the lengths of the sides.

4 in. + 6 in. + 7 in. + 5 in. + 11 in. + 11 in. = 44 in.

The perimeter of the figure is 44 inches.
